CHUBB, James

James Chubb was born in 1884 in Lyme Regis. His parents were George Chubb (of Tytheleigh 1855-1900) and Jane (nee Trott of Membury 1858-1896). They had 6 children: Elizabeth (b 1879), Walter (b 1882), Francis (b 1887), Sarah (b 1889) and James (b 1894).

Jane Trott, mother had been married before and had had a son, John Goldsworthy born in 1849

In 1901 James was living with his uncle John Goldworthy who was an agricultural labourer born in Membury, and wife Sarah (nee Gillingham) a lace maker born in Chardstock and their son John G Goldsworthy (16 an agricultural labourer) in Flower House, Smallridge.

In 1911, James, aged 17, was still living with John and Sarah at Churchill, and was working as a road marker.

It is not clear as to why James Chubb was recorded on the Membury list, unless perhaps after 1911 he had come to Membury to work, or because his mother's family lived here.
