ENDICOTT, George

A Reginald Edwin George Endicott was baptised in Wambrook on 31 July 1892. His parents were Robert Endicott and Mary Ann (nee Newbery b 1853 in Membury).

In 1901, his mother was a widow and living at Playstreet, Membury, with daughter Elizabeth (15) working as a domestic servant, Robert (12), Reginald (8) and a cousin Ambrose Endicott (43) a stone quarryman.

In 1911 George Endicott aged 18 was a cowman living at Crawley Cottage, Wambrook with Sarah French (61) and children aged from 18 to 26.

In 1911, Ambrose Enticott (60) a bag maker and Mary Ann Enticott (listed as his wife) still lived at Play Street with a granddaughter Rosie (5).

No military record found for him.

In early 1920, Reginald E G Endicott marries Florence Diamond (reg in Honiton) and they had 3 sons Eric (1921) Ivan (1928), and Arnold (1932) all reg in Honiton.
